

Carsington Water Map

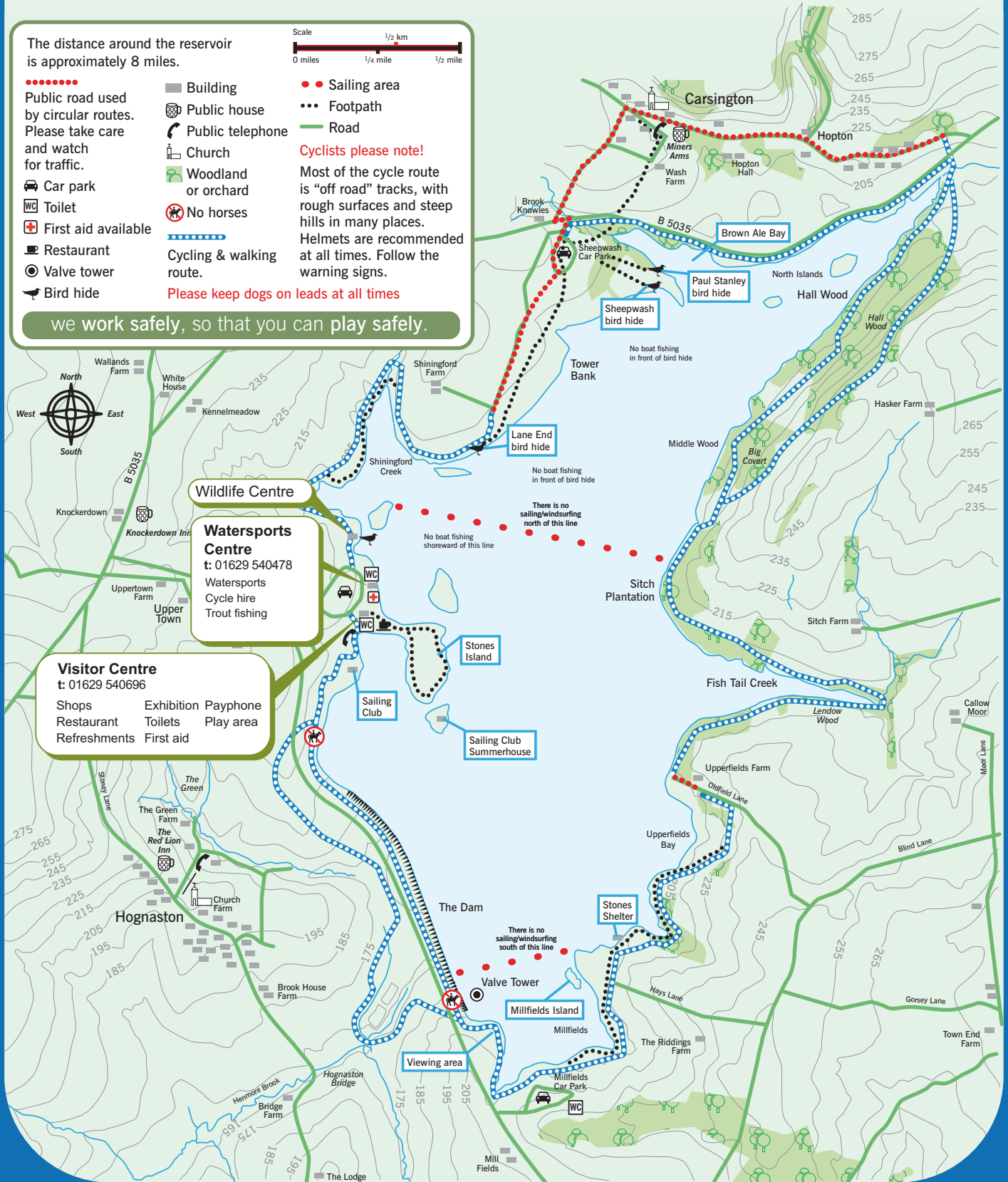
