

ACCESSIBLE MINNINGLOW ROUTE - ONE-WAY

Route Information

Accessible Minninglow route - one-way

A lovely route without stiles that's suitable for all, including off-road wheelchairs (though take a friend along to help with the gates!).

Starting in the car park outside the log cabins, head between Hipley and Daisybank to find the single-width gate into the paddock. Go up to the bigger gate ahead of you and through, before tracking right towards the big tree. Go round the tree and follow the wall up the hill, keeping the field boundary on your right. Once you hit the top, bear left to find the gate in the wall ahead of you onto the High Peak Trail.

Head left on the trail, past Daisy Bank barn on your left and you'll already see Minninglow on the horizon on your right. Turn right at the crossroads onto Gallows Lane - it's a bit of a hairpin bend back on yourself, so you might need to do a three-point turn if you're in an all-terrain wheelchair!

Head through the gate onto the lane and follow it until you see another gate on your left with a signpost pointing up the hill towards Minninglow, marked "Accessible route".

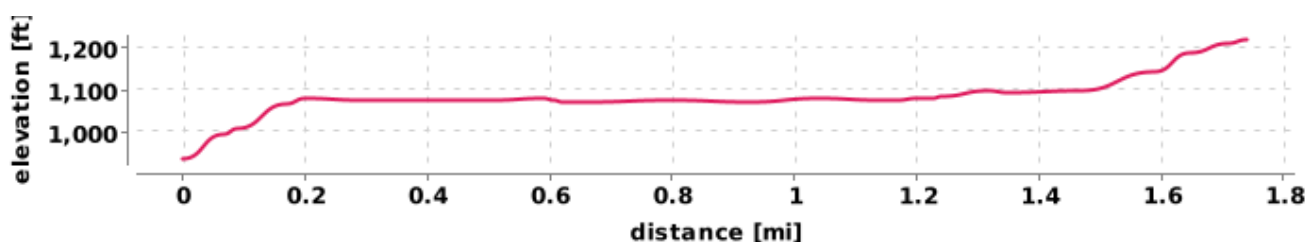
Go through the gate, head for the next gap in the wall ahead of you, and follow the signposted accessible route up to the top!

Enjoy the views, take a rest, and explore this magical ancient burial ground before you head back the same way.
